Opening hours

We offer sessions from 9am – 12pm and 12pm – 3pm for 2, 3 and 4 year olds. For 3 and 4 year olds only, additional sessions can be booked, from 8am – 9am and 3pm – 6pm.

Dining Club

We offer nursery children the chance to become part of our Dining Club where between one and five lunches per week can be purchased in advance, with a pre-order of your child's menu choices. Lunch is included at the end of the morning session or the beginning of the afternoon session, depending on your child's session pattern. Alternatively, you can provide your child with a packed lunch.

Early Years Entitlement & Extended Entitlement (30 hours)

All children are entitled to 15 hours funding per week (up to a total of 570 hours per academic year) from the start of the term after their 3rd birthday. Some children qualify for 30 hours funding per week (up to a total of 1140 per academic year). Funding may be split between providers.

Some children qualify for 15 hours funding per week from the start of the term after their 2nd birthday. If you have not received a 'golden ticket' for your child, and you think that your child may qualify, please contact Devon County Council (0345 155 1013).

Hourly Rate

Our hourly rate is currently £4.90 for 2 year olds and £4.00 for 3 and 4 year olds, which is charged for hours over and above funding and for non-funded children. These sums are subject to change.

Invoices

Invoices for any un-funded hours are sent out at the beginning of every term. Payment is made online, using a system called 'WisePay', on the school's website. We also accept childcare vouchers.
